The Diversité cuvee is sourced from multiple blocks on our vineyard showcasing the diverse soils, sunlight exposure, and clonal variation found throughout the estate.

Tasting notes: Unfiltered – a bit of bacon-meat-game on the nose is followed by diverse flavors of blueberry, boysenberry, black cherry, anise, and fresh roasted coffee beans.

Notes from release in 2010: Scott Shull in his first vintage as a Le Cadeau consulting winemaker has crafted a beautiful Pinot Noir that offers great intensity. One of the few unfiltered wines ever produced by Le Cadeau, the '08 Diversité is more hearty than elegant, yet it has refinement and precision. Like its predecessors, the 2008 is a bit on the wild side – its hue is ruby-midnight-blue and the wine's aromatics are a blend of ripe boysenberry and fresh ground French-roast coffee. It features intense flavors of blueberry, blackberry, licorice, earth and a little smoke. Drinking window: 2011-on.
