



2009 “Diversité” Pinot Noir

The Diversité cuvee is sourced from multiple blocks on our vineyard showcasing the diverse soils, sunlight exposure, and clonal variation found throughout the estate.

Notes from release in 2011: Aromas of sweet candied pears, kirsch liqueur, and blackberries offer clues of the rich wine to follow. The '09 Diversité is beautifully balanced with soft tannins and medium acidity in a viscous texture. Up front black raspberry and marionberry flavors yield to a minty-spicy mid-palate of clove and hints of characteristic Oregon white pepper. The dark blue fruit finish is sweet and lingering with tones of root beer and minerals. Best in late-2012 and beyond.
