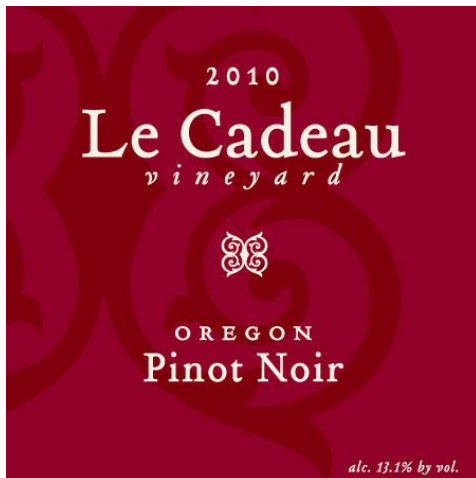




2010 Le Cadeau – Red Label Pinot Noir

The 2010 Red Label Pinot Noir is crafted from 100% estate-grown fruit, primarily sourced from the Côte Est blocks in the Eastern-side of Le Cadeau Vineyard. One barrel of 2010 Le Cadeau Rocheux was contributed to the blend (17%), adding minerality and additional complexity.

Tasting Notes:

Beautiful translucent ruby color with excellent clarity. Aromas of strawberries, fresh red cherries, and raspberry. On the palate, bright, fresh, cherry flavors with accents of cinnamon and vanilla-- wrapped in a soft, round, texture, and finishing with persistent acidity and the characteristic Le Cadeau minerality.
